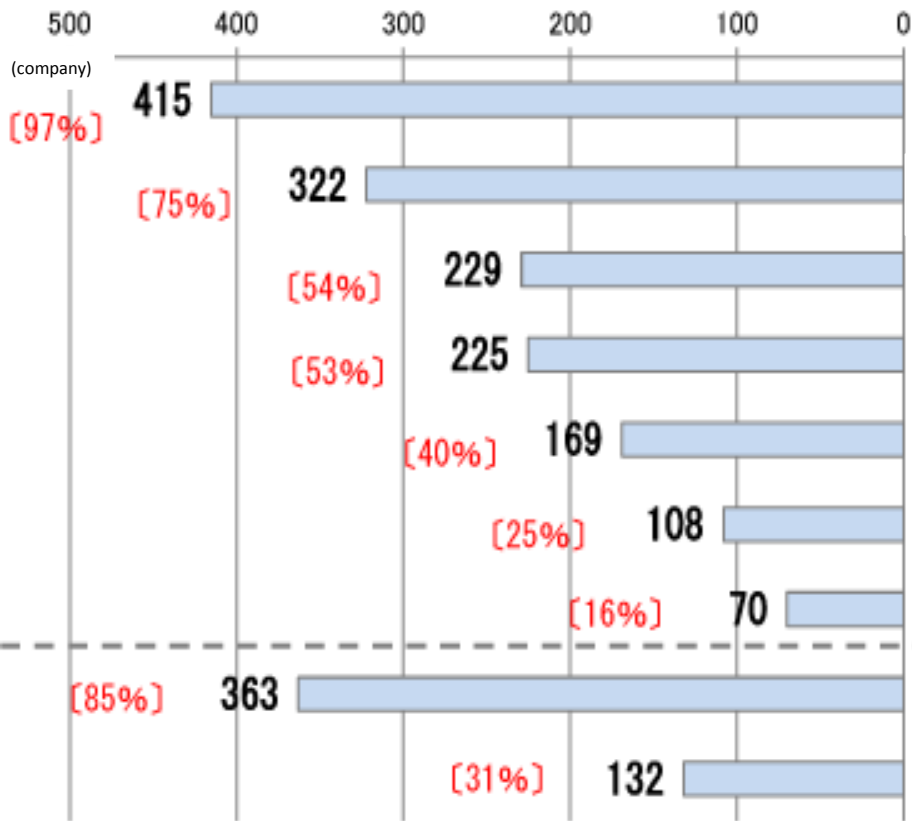
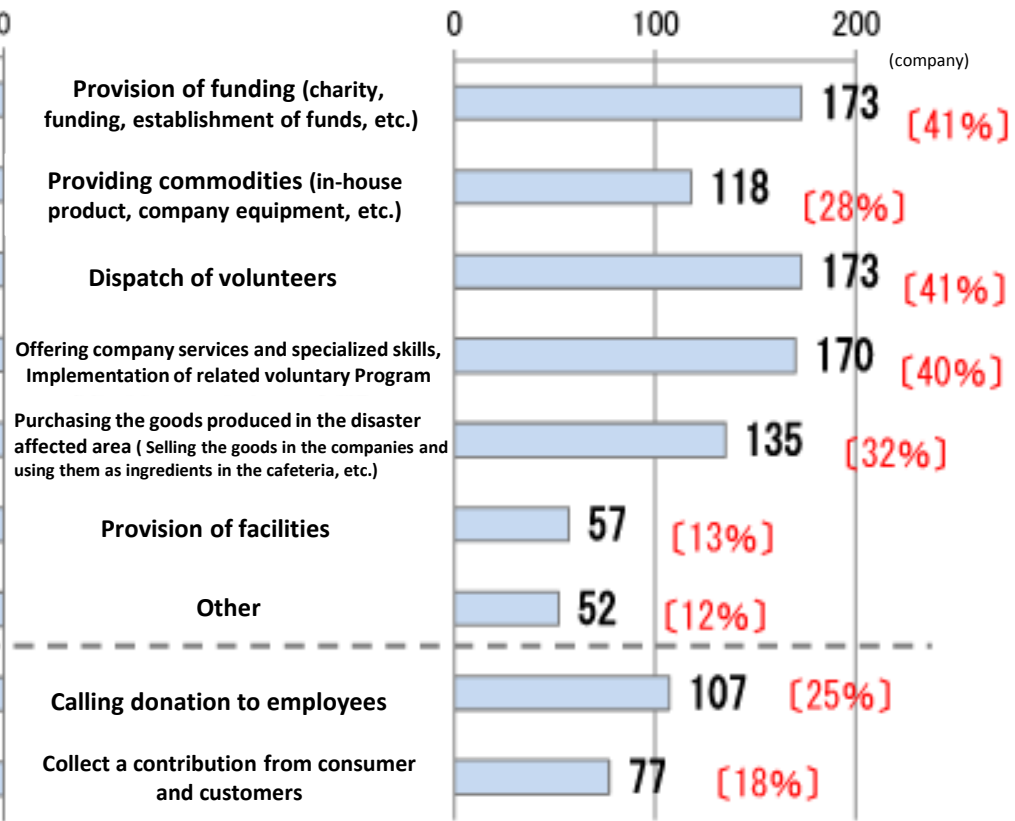


# Status of Company Support for people and Areas Affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake
