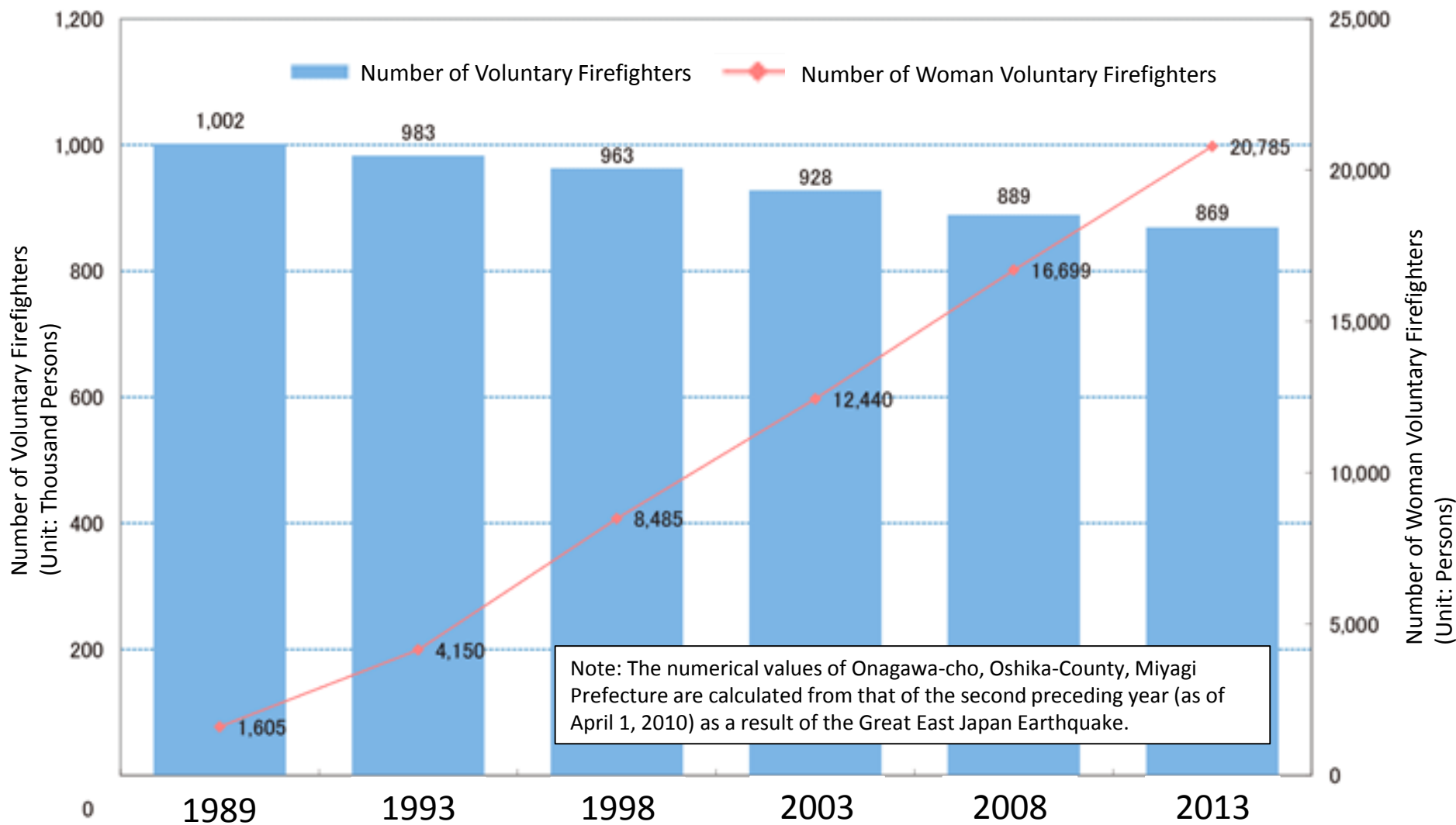


Change in Number of Voluntary Firefighters
