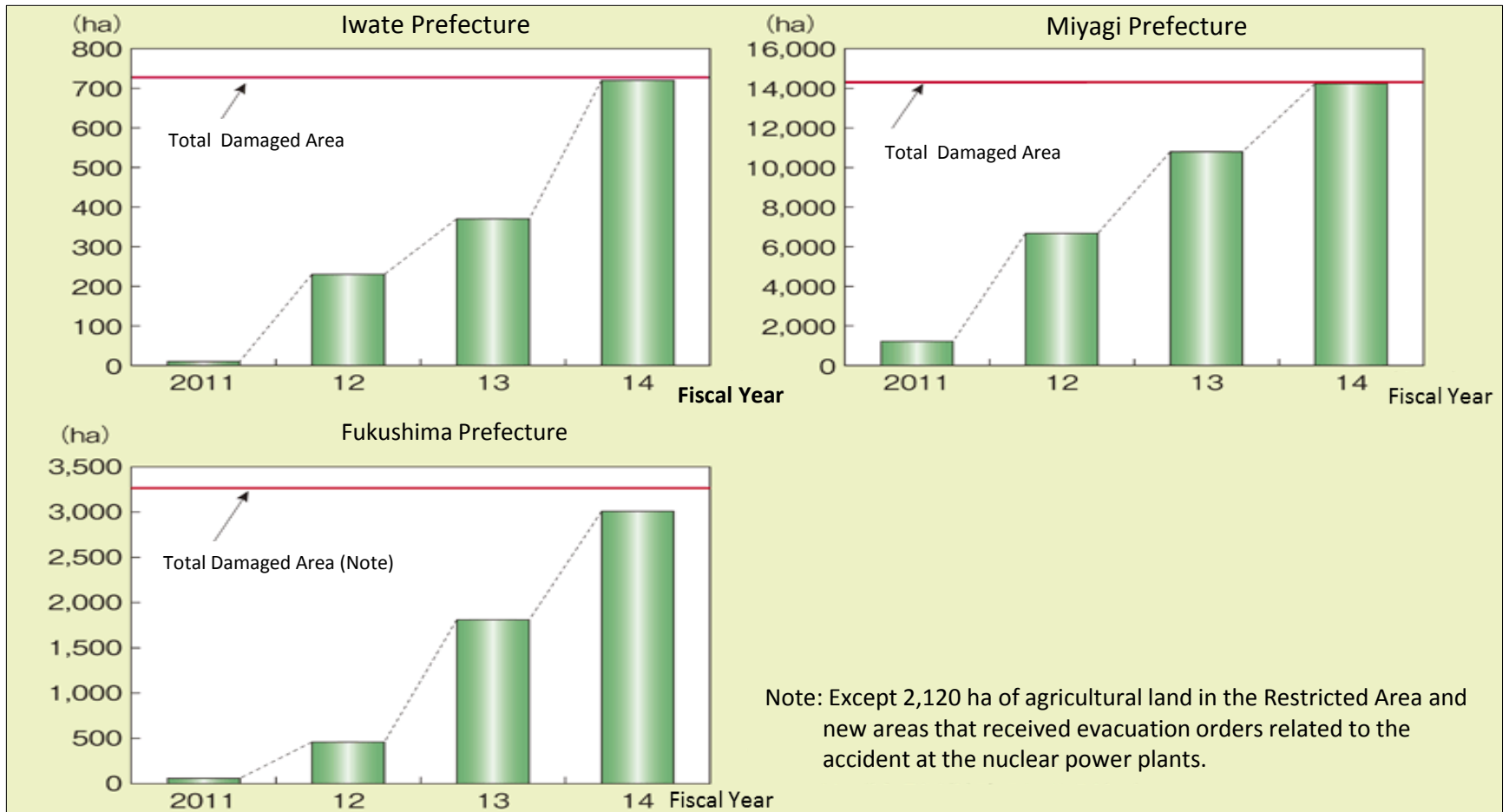


Change in Area of Possibility for Resume of Farming in Three Affected Prefectures
